

JYM THYSSENKRUPP STEEL INTERNSHIP PROGRAM APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The JYM ThyssenKrupp Steel Internship program consists of an 8-week internship in the *Ruhrgebiet*, followed by full-participation in the JYM Second Semester Program option in Munich. The internship is scheduled to begin January 25, 2010 (the exact date is subject to change); the JYM Second Semester Program begins March 29 and ends July 24, 2010.

Eligibility Requirements

- US citizenship; currently enrolled in an accredited US college/university; transcript; references
- 3 semesters of college-level German (or the equivalent) with an average grade of B; overall GPA 3.0
- Students must meet all other Admission Requirements for the JYM Second Semester Program option (see *JYM Programs* on our website)

Application Stages

The application procedure for the JYM ThyssenKrupp Steel Internship program takes place in 2 stages.

Stage 1) JYM first needs to collect information about your qualifications and your preferred field of internship. We will then forward this information to ThyssenKrupp Steel in Duisburg, Germany where our partners will see if they can find an appropriate internship in your field of interest.

Please submit the following by email to JYM by **August 1, 2009**:

- 1) the two-page JYM ThyssenKrupp Steel Internship Application Form
- 2) a resume in German (*Lebenslauf* - a sample can be downloaded on our website; see *Internships*)
- 3) a copy of your current university transcript

It may take a number of weeks before it can be determined if an internship for you is possible, and placement can not be guaranteed in advance. You will be informed as soon as we learn if an internship position will be offered to you.

Stage 2) If ThyssenKrupp Steel is able to offer you an internship and you accept it, you will then need to apply for admission to JYM by October 1, 2009. You can download the JYM Application Form online. See *How to Apply* on our website.
